

RESOLUTION NO. 102


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Redmond feels that it is in the public interest that the citizens of the Redmond area have adequate, direct and unimpeded access to the Evergreen Point Bridge now being built across Lake Washington, and


Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Redmond desires to go on record as being in favor of and strongly urging that there be a State of Washington Highway extension from the east approach of the Evergreen Point Bridge to the Redmond Vicinity,
NOW THEREFORE,

The Town of Redmond does hereby approve and request that the State of Washington establish a State Highway extension from the east approach of the Evergreen Point Bridge to the immediate vicinity of Redmond, Washington, and that immediate action be taken by the State of Washington to establish such extension.
