RESOLUTION NO. 104

WHEREAS, the Town of Redmond, through its Mayor and Council, deems it advisable and in the public interest to declare and dedicate a portion of property owned by it for use as a public road and way, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Redmond, through its Council, does hereby declare and dedicate the use of the following described property:

The West 30 feet of the North Half of the North Half of the East One-Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., situated in King County, State of Washington;

and establish the same as a right-of-way for a public road and for all other public uses and purposes not inconsistent with the use thereof for public highway purposes, TOGETHER WITH the right to make all necessary slopes, for cuts and fills, on the adjoining Town of Redmond property in the original reasonable grading of the public highway.

Regularly passed and adopted by the Town Council of Redmond, Washington, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1961.
