

ORDINANCE NO. 11

An Ordinance regulating the driving of motor vehicles and bicycles in the Town of Redmond and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:-

-1-

RIDING ON SIDE WALKS

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle or motorcycle on any side walk inside the Town of Redmond. Any person guilty of so riding a bicycle or motorcycle shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed Ten Dollars.

Repealed SPEED OF AUTOMOBILES
by Ordinance # 30

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any automobile, motorcycle or any motor vehicle upon any of the streets of the Town of Redmond at a speed of twenty miles or more per hour and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive any such vehicle upon Leary Street from the southerly limits of the Town of Redmond to where Jackson Street intersects Leary Street at a greater speed than ten miles per hour. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not more than Fifty Dollars.
