

RESOLUTION NO. 112

A RESOLUTION of the City of Redmond, Washington, pertaining to the regulation of speed limits and parking restrictions upon state highways within the corporate limits of the City.

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission, the maximum lawful speed allowed upon the following state highways within the corporate limits of the City of Redmond shall be as follows:

Forty (40) miles per hour upon that portion of SS-2D from the west city limits to the south city limits;

Twenty-five (25) miles per hour upon that portion of Redmond Way from the junction of SS-2D to its junction with PS-2;

Twenty-five (25) miles per hour upon that portion of PS-2 from the north city limits to its junction with Redmond Way;

Twenty-five (25) miles per hour upon that portion of PS-2 from its junction with Redmond Way to the east city limits.


Section 2 - Subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission, time limit parking control upon all state highways within the corporate limits of the City of Redmond shall be as posted.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1962.
