

RESOLUTION NO. 117

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of Redmond, Washington relating to the establishment of approach roads and feeder system for the Second Lake Washington Bridge and approving a Resolution and proposal by the Lake Washington Good Roads Association.

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 113 did recommend a certain re-location of State Secondary Highways No. 2-D as described therein; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Washington Good Roads Association has made further study concerning bridge approach routes encompassing the re-location of S.S.H. 2D and has, by resolution, made a further proposal for this re-location; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, having examined said resolution and further proposal, now finds that the recommendations by the Lake Washington Good Roads Association are worthy of consideration and are in the best interests of the citizens of Redmond, the Bellevue, Houghton, Kirkland and Redmond areas, and the State of Washington, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Redmond do endorse and approve the Resolution by the Lake Washington Good Roads Association, dated July 11, 1962, concerning the re-location of S.S.H. 2D, and do earnestly recommend that the State Good Roads Association take immediate action before the Washington State Legislature in order that the program therein proposed may be implemented without delay.
