

RESOLUTION NO. 118

A RESOLUTION, relating to street improvement and providing for the City to enter into an agreement with King County for the improvement of a portion of 166th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS, that portion of 166th Avenue N.E. lying within the City of Redmond and extending north to the city limits is in need of improvement and the city is unable to maintain said street or make the necessary improvement except at considerable expense; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the actual cost of the improvement by King County is \$ 2,500<sup>00</sup> and the City desires to enter into an agreement and authorize the Board of Commissioners of King County, Washington to perform such improvement as provided by R.C.W. 47.24.050, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - That the Board of Commissioners of King County, Washington be authorized to perform improvement upon 166th Avenue N.E., lying within the City of Redmond and extending from N.E. 95th Street north to the city limits, at the actual cost thereof; such improvement to consist of a light bituminous surface treatment and to be performed in accordance with King County Standards and the applicable design standards adopted by the state design standards committee.

Section 2 - That the Mayor and City Clerk be empowered to execute an agreement with said Board of Commissioners of King County for the performance of all or any part of such improvement as may be recommended by the Street Committee of the City Council; provided that in no event shall the cost thereof exceed the sum of \$5,000.00.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 11<sup>TH</sup> day of September, 1962.
