

RESOLUTION NO. 119

A RESOLUTION of the City of Redmond, Washington, revising and extending the six year comprehensive street program adopted by Resolution No. 109 on December 13, 1961.

WHEREAS, it having been recommended to the City Council that the six year comprehensive street program, as adopted by Resolution No. 109 on December 13, 1961, be revised and extended to include the further improvement of 166th Avenue N. E. from N. E. 95th Street north to the city limits, and

WHEREAS, the City Council having set the 27th day of November, 1962, at 8:00 P.M., as the date and time for a public hearing upon said proposed revision and extension and the hearing having been duly held after notice having been published, and

IT APPEARING to the City Council that a revision and extension of the six year comprehensive street program should be made, NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, that the six year comprehensive street program as adopted by Resolution No. 109 on December 13, 1961, is hereby revised and extended to include the following street improvements:

166th Ave. N.E.	N.E. 95th St.	North city limits	Grade, surface, storm drain, curb and gutter
N.E. 104th St.	172nd Ave. NE	1320 Ft. M/L easterly	Grade, surface, storm drain, curb and gutter


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall file duplicate copies of this Resolution with the Director of Highways of the State of Washington within thirty (30) days after the date this Resolution is adopted.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 27th day of November, 1962.


