

RESOLUTION NO. 121

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intention of the City Council of the City of Redmond to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of certain improvements upon N.E. 104th Street, extending from 166th Avenue N.E. to 172nd Avenue N.E.; and fixing a date for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Redmond and is necessary for the public peace, safety and welfare that N.E. 104th Street, extending from 166th Avenue N.E. to 172nd Avenue N.E. be improved by the construction of grades, cuts and fills, surfacing, curbs, gutters, storm drainage and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having further determined that said improvement should be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property within the proposed improvement district; that a local improvement district should be formed for the construction of the improvement; and that a date for a public hearing thereon should be fixed, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - The City Council hereby declares its intention to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of improvements upon N.E. 104th Street, extending from 166th Avenue N.E. to 172nd Avenue N.E., consisting of grades, cuts and fills, surfacing, curbs, gutters, storm drainage and sidewalks, or so much thereof as may prove practicable.

Section 2 - That the cost of the improvement be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property within the proposed improvement district in the manner provided by law. (R.C.W. 35.43 et seq.).


Section 3 - That the City Engineer be authorized and directed to prepare the preliminary estimates and assessment roll and certify the same to the City Council in the manner provided by R.C.W. 35.43.130 to be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 4 - That the date of Mar. 12, 1963 at the

hour of 8:00 P.M. at the City Hall is hereby set as the time and place for a public hearing on this Resolution and the City Clerk is directed to publish this Resolution and to give proper notice of said hearing in the manner and form required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12TH day of February, 1963.


