

RESOLUTION NO. 127

A RESOLUTION, approving a petition for an election to vote upon the annexation of certain territory to the City of Redmond; requiring that a proposition be submitted in connection therewith concerning taxation to pay for the existing indebtedness of the City; and providing for the notification to the petitioners of the action taken by the City Council on such petition.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Annexation Election to the City of Redmond, Washington, was presented to and filed with the City Council on August 27, 1963, requesting that an election be held within the territory therein described on the question of the annexation of such territory to the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused said petition to be examined and it has been found to contain the requisite number of signatures as required by RCW 35.13.020 (Ch. 282, §7, Laws of 1961) and in all other respects has met the requirements of the laws of the State of Washington concerning annexation of unincorporated areas by cities under the election method contained in RCW 35.13.020 through RCW 35.13.120 (Ch. 245, Laws of 1907 and amendments thereto); and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the proposed annexation of the territory described below will be for the general benefit of the City of Redmond and the general benefit of the area to be annexed, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the proposed election to vote upon the annexation of contiguous, unincorporated territory to the City of Redmond, as evidenced by the Petition for Annexation Election to the City of Redmond, Washington, filed with the City Council on August 27, 1963, is hereby approved. Said

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.; THENCE NORTH, ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SAID SUBDIVISION, TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER THEREOF; THENCE WESTERLY, ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SUBDIVISION, TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER THEREOF (INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SAID SECTION 14); THENCE NORTHERLY, ALONG SAID CENTERLINE, TO THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY MARGIN OF N.E. 51ST STREET; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY, ALONG SAID NORTH MARGIN, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY MARGIN OF THE BELLEVUE-REDMOND ROAD; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY, ALONG SAID NORTHEASTERLY MARGIN, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.; THENCE EASTERLY, ALONG SAID EAST-WEST CENTERLINE, TO THE CENTER OF SAID SECTION 13; THENCE NORTHERLY, ALONG THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SAID SECTION 13, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTERLINE OF THE SAMMAMISH RIVER; THENCE SOUTHERLY, ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF THE SAMMAMISH RIVER AND THE CENTERLINE OF LAKE SAMMAMISH, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 6 EAST, W.M. PROLONGED EASTERLY; THENCE WESTERLY, ALONG THE PROLONGED SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 30, TO THE EASTERLY LINE OF THE SECOND CLASS SHORELAND OF LAKE SAMMAMISH; THENCE SOUTHERLY, ALONG SAID EASTERLY LINE, TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY PROLONGATION OF THE SOUTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF LOT 105, ROSEMONT BEACH ADDITION, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 34 OF PLATS, PAGE 28, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY, ALONG SAID BOUNDARY, TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY MARGIN OF SECONDARY STATE HIGHWAY No. 2-D; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY, ALONG SAID MARGIN, TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 30; THENCE WESTERLY, ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 30 AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M., TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST HALF OF SAID SECTION 25; THENCE NORTHERLY, ALONG THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SAID SECTION 25, TO THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 25; THENCE CONTINUING NORTHERLY, ALONG THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M., TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY MARGIN OF N.E. 40TH STREET; THENCE WESTERLY, ALONG SAID SOUTH MARGIN, TO AN INTERSECTION WITH A LINE, SAID LINE BEING THE SOUTHERLY PROLONGATION OF THE EAST LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 14; THENCE NORTHERLY, ALONG SAID PROLONGED LINE, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.


2. That there shall also be submitted to the electorate of the territory proposed for annexation, a proposition that all property within the area to be annexed shall, upon annexation be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as the property within the City of Redmond is assessed and taxed to pay for any then outstanding indebtedness of the City of Redmond, contracted prior to, or existing at the date of annexation.

3. That the City Clerk shall cause notice to be given to the petitioners of the action taken by the City Council with regard to this petition by the publication of this Resolution in the manner provided by law.

4. That following the notice by publication, as aforesaid, the City Clerk shall forward the Petition for Annexation Election to the City of Redmond, Washington, to the Board of County Commissioners for King County, Washington, and said Board is hereby requested to act upon said petition and to call an election upon the proposed annexation as soon as the same may be done expediently under the law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 10th day of September, 1963.


