

RESOLUTION NO. 129

A RESOLUTION, relating to the placement of electrical transmission lines by Puget Sound Power & Light Company within the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, it is understood that Puget Sound Power & Light Company is seeking a 250 foot right-of-way for electrical transmission lines and steel towers from a point northeast of and terminating at a point west of Redmond on Willows Road; and

WHEREAS, the presently proposed route of such right-of-way crosses property within and immediately adjacent to the City Limits of Redmond, crossing such property diagonally without reference to grid or section lines, and crosses State-owned property set aside for school purposes and prime development property vital to the future growth and development of the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable and in keeping with sound governmental principles for the protection of the public health and welfare that the route of such a proposed right-of-way be coordinated within the framework of proper comprehensive planning so as to cause the least possible interference with the economic utilization of existing properties in the orderly growth and development of the Redmond area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed route of the Puget Sound Power & Light Company right-of-way does not appear to be in conformity with the objectives of proper planning; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that Puget Sound Power & Light Company be requested to meet with the Redmond Planning Commission to consider the proper planning of the proposed route of its electrical transmission line and to explore the possibilities of alternate routes which would be less likely to disrupt the orderly, long range

planning for the development of the City of Redmond and adjacent properties;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Service Commission of the State of Washington be requested to take appropriate steps in the interest of the public health and welfare to assure the proper placement and route of the proposed right-of-way in conformity with sound planning principles;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Department of Public lands be requested to deny permission to Puget Sound Power & Light Company to acquire a right-of-way across State-owned property north of the city limits of Redmond which has been set aside for school purposes and which is contemplated as a site for a community junior college within the Lake Washington School District.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12TH day of November, 1963.


