

ORDINANCE NO 13

An Ordinance Providing the Method of Assessing and Collecting Taxes levied for Municipal Purposes in the Town of Redmond.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as Follows:-

Section 1.

That said Town of Redmond adopt and it does hereby adopt the method for the assessment and collection of taxes levied for Municipal purposes as set out and contained in the laws and statutes of the State of Washington in such cases made and provided and particularly Section 9290 to 9299, both inclusive, in Remington & Ballinger Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington.

Section II.

That the Town Clerk of Redmond be and he is hereby directed as soon as this Ordinance shall become effective to deliver a copy of this Ordinance to the County Assessor of King County and likewise to the County Treasurer of King County.
