

RESOLUTION NO. 131

A RESOLUTION, declaring the intention of the City Council of the City of Redmond to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of certain improvements upon Redmond Way, extending from the Railroad Overpass to 515 feet east of 168th Avenue N.E.; and fixing a date for a public hearing thereon.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best public interest of the City of Redmond and is necessary for the public peace, safety and welfare that Redmond Way, extending from the Railroad Overpass to 515 feet east of 168th Avenue N.E. be improved by the construction of asphalt paving, grading, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways across sidewalks, and storm drainage; and

WHEREAS, said street forms and is a part of the State Highway System within the city limits of Redmond and the State Highway Department has indicated that it would undertake the improvement of said street by asphalt paving, provided the City causes said street to be improved by the construction of curbs, gutters, and storm drainage; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having further determined that said improvement, except for asphalt paving, should be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property within the proposed improvement district; that a local improvement district should be formed for the construction of the improvement; and that a date for a public hearing thereon should be fixed, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. - The City Council hereby declares its intention to order the formation of a local improvement district for the construction of improvements upon Redmond Way, extending from the Railroad Overpass to 515 feet east of 168th Avenue N.E., consisting of grading, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways across sidewalks, and storm drainage.

Section 2. - That the cost of the improvement be paid in whole or in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property

within the proposed improvement district in the manner provided by law. (R.C.W. 35.43 et seq.).

Section 3. - That the City Engineer be authorized and directed to prepare the preliminary estimates and assessment roll and certify the same to the City Council in the manner provided by R.C.W. 35.43.130 to be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 4. - That the date of January 14, 1964 at the hour of 8:00 P.M. at the City Hall before the City Council is hereby set as the time and place for a public hearing on the Resolution and the City Clerk is directed to publish this Resolution and to give proper notice of said hearing in the manner and form required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 10th day of December, 1963.


