

RESOLUTION NO. 133

A RESOLUTION, providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in the Current Expense Fund under the general class Capital Outlay based upon unanticipated revenues in said fund.

WHEREAS, funds have been received in the Current Expense Fund in excess of the estimated revenues in said fund and class at the time the annual estimates were made and the City Council finds it appropriate and in the public interest that said unanticipated revenues be expended in order to provide suitable quarters for the newly created office of Public Works and to provide engineering equipment and supplies for such office, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND:

Section 1 - That the sum of \$ 3000.⁰⁰, received by the City of Redmond in excess of anticipated revenues, is hereby budgeted and appropriated for expenditures in providing suitable quarters for the office of Public Works through the renovation of a portion of the City Hall and for engineering equipment and supplies for such office under the general class Capital Outlay within the Current Expense Fund.

Section 2 - That this appropriation shall take effect immediately upon the passage of this Resolution.
