RESOLUTION NO. 134

A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held for the City Council upon a Petition for ~~the~~ <sup>DATE</sup> vacation of a portion of 136th Avenue N.E. 1-28-64

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk on December 9, 1963 and presented to the City Council, requesting that the City Council ~~vacate~~ <sup>BY ORDINANCE No. 134</sup> certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

That portion of 136th Avenue N.E. which lies between the north boundary of N.E. 80th Street and the south boundary of N.E. 83rd Street, an approximate distance of 630.16 feet lying within the southwest quarter of Section 3, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED


That the date of January 28, 1964 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street, to be held at the City Hall before the City Council;

That the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
