

RESOLUTION NO. 137

A RESOLUTION, adopting a Comprehensive Drainage and Storm Sewer Plan for the City of Redmond and providing for revisions thereto.

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused a study to be made by Livingstone and Moore, Consulting Engineers, Seattle, Washington, of present and future drainage problems within the Redmond area, together with proposed means and facilities for providing adequate storm sewers and drains to meet present and anticipated needs of the City upon a comprehensive and coordinated basis; and such study having been made and presented to the City Council by letter dated January 29, 1964; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having reviewed such study and having held a public hearing concerning the adoption of a comprehensive storm drainage plan for the City of Redmond on February 25, 1964, and finding the recommendations of Livingstone and Moore adequately meet the present and anticipated needs of the City; NOW, THEREFORE


BE IT RESOLVED that the Comprehensive Drainage and Storm Sewer Plan, prepared by Livingstone and Moore, Consulting Engineers, and presented to the City Council by letter dated January 29, 1964, incorporated herein by this reference thereto, is hereby adopted as the Comprehensive Drainage Plan for the City of Redmond, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such Comprehensive Drainage Plan shall be reviewed periodically in light of work accomplished under the Plan and the then present and anticipated drainage needs; and such Plan may be hereafter revised, amended, and/or extended by majority action of the City Council to reflect the needs and conditions then existing or anticipated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the declared intention and policy of the City of Redmond shall be that all future construction and reconstruction of drainage facilities within the City of Redmond be accomplished and implemented, according to existing and future needs, as a part of and in conformance with the Comprehensive Drainage Plan hereby adopted and as hereafter revised, amended and/or extended, whether such work be done by the City or privately in the development of individual properties.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 10th day of March, 1964.
