

RESOLUTION NO. 139

A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the vacation of a portion of N.E. 28th Street.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk on July 23, 1964, and presented to the City Council, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, and described as follows:

That portion of N.E. 28th Street lying westerly from 180th Avenue N.E., and described as follows: The north 30.00 feet of the west 623.22 feet of the east 653.22 feet of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 24, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the date of August 25, 1964, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. is hereby fixed as the date and time for the public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street to be held at the City Hall before the City Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
