

RESOLUTION NO. 140

A RESOLUTION, of the City of Redmond, Washington, authorizing the sale of sixty-two 20,000 lumen mercury vapor street light fixtures to Puget Sound Power & Light Company.

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Power & Light Company, a public utility corporation, hereafter called "Puget," has offered to purchase the mercury vapor street lights presently owned by the City of Redmond, hereafter called "City," which are located upon Puget-owned utility poles, and to assume and undertake the maintenance, operation and replacement of such street lighting fixtures within the City, including the placement of new fixtures within the City as needed; and

WHEREAS, the City presently owns sixty-two 20,000 lumen, mercury vapor street light fixtures and appurtenances, which are located upon Puget-owned utility poles, and the City Council has determined that the sale of such street light fixtures to Puget is in the best public interest, NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED That the sale to Puget of sixty-two 20,000 lumen mercury street light fixtures and appurtenances located upon Puget-owned utility poles within the City of Redmond, at a price of \$45.00 for each street light fixture, is hereby authorized; provided, that Puget will agree to assume and undertake the maintenance, operation and replacement of such street lighting fixtures within the City thereafter, so that adequate street lighting service to the area will be continued; and further, that Puget will agree to place new street lighting fixtures within the City in areas needing such service when requested to do so by the City, it being understood that the City will pay a standard service charge to Puget for maintenance and operation of Puget-owned street lighting fixtures and the furnishing of electrical energy thereto, in accordance with rates

now or hereafter established for such service as approved by the Public Service Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Mayor be empowered to execute a bill of sale to Puget for the sale of such street lighting fixtures, upon the receipt of the purchase money therefor and the acceptance by Puget of the terms of this Resolution.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 25th day of August, 1964.
