

RESOLUTION NO. 146

A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held for the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of 168th Ave. N.E.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk on November 24, 1964, and presented to the City Council, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

A deeded public road R.O.W. 60 feet in width and 270.88 feet long comprising approximately .268 acres described as follows:

That portion of 168th Ave. N.E. lying southerly of the easterly extension of the south R.O.W. margin of N.E. 89th Street and northerly of the north margin of N.E. 88th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED


That the date of December 22nd, 1964 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street, to be held at the City Hall before the City Council;

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 24th day of November, 1964.


