## RESOLUTION NO. 149

A RESOLUTION of the City of Redmond, Washington, commending and thanking the HONORABLE CHARLES W. JOHNSON, JR. for his services as the first Judge of the Worthlake District Justice Court during January 14, 1963 to February 1, 1965.
