

ORDINANCE NO. 15

An Ordinance Prohibiting certain Minors from being in Public
Places in certain hours.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as
follows:-

(1) It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of
Sixteen Years years to be abroad upon the public streets
or in any other public place after the hour of 9
o'clock in the evening from April 1st to April 30th
in any year, or after the hour of Eight o'clock in the
evening from October 1st to March 31st of any
year unless accompanied by one or both parents or his guardian
or by an adult sanctioned by the parents or guardian; and any
minor who shall violate any of the provisions of this section
shall be subject to arrest by any police officer without process
and upon the first offense shall be taken and delivered into the
custody of his parents or guardian and upon a second arrest may
in the discretion of the person making the arrest, be taken
before the Police Justice or the Juvenile Court and shall be
subject to a fine of not to exceed Five Dollars.
