

RESOLUTION NO. 152

A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of 170th Avenue N. E.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council July 13, 1965, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

That portion of 170th Avenue N. E. within the plat of Redcrest Addition as recorded in volume 59 of plats, page 46, records of King County, Washington, lying north of the northerly right-of-way margin of N. E. 90th Street and south of the southerly right-of-way margin of N. E. 92nd Street. Situate in the City of Redmond, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED


