Setting Mayor's Vehicle Allowance

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING A VEHICLE ALLOWANCE FOR THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Redmond uses his/her personal vehicle extensively on City business, both locally and regionally; and,

WHEREAS, current recordkeeping practices make it impractical to require the Mayor to keep track of the total mileage traveled using his/her personal vehicle on City business, therefore precluding the Mayor from being fully reimbursed for such use; and,

WHEREAS, a vehicle allowance in lieu of all other mileage reimbursement for the Mayor's use of his/her personal vehicle on City business is a desirable substitute for the current practice; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The mayor shall receive a vehicle allowance in the amount of \$225 (two hundred twenty-

five dollars) per month as the exclusive method of reimbursing the Mayor for use of his/her personal vehicle on City business. The Mayor's vehicle allowance shall be in lieu of any mileage or other reimbursement by the City to the Mayor for use of a personal vehicle on City business.

<u>Section 2.</u> Payment of the vehicle allowance to the Mayor shall be made in addition to the salary or such other compensation as the Council may from time to time establish for the Mayor.

Section 3. The vehicle allowance established by this ordinance shall be effective as of 1 January 1990.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.
