AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$97,739 TO FUND THE BUDGET, PERSONNEL AND POLICY ANALYSTS POSITIONS CONTAINED IN THE USER FEE RECOMMENDATIONS, AND MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO CITY BUDGETS AND AMENDING ORDINANCES 1528, 1540 AND 1554

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has identified the need to make certain revisions to the 1990 City budget, and the City Council has reviewed the proposed adjustments and has determined that they should be made, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 1528 adopting the 1990 budget, passed by the City Council on December 5, 1989, and as amended by Ordinance Nos. 1540 and 1554, is hereby amended by revising Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 1528, to authorize the expenditure of \$97,739 to fund the Budget, Personnel and Policy Analysts positions contained in the User Fee Recommendations and set forth in Exhibit I attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. The source of funds for the increased appropriations are revised building permit revenues and user fee increases approved by the Council on March 20.

This Ordinance being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take full effect five (5) days

after publication.
