

RESOLUTION NO. 156

A RESOLUTION, approving the grant of an electrical transmission line easement to Puget Sound Power and Light Company and authorizing the Mayor to sign and execute the same on behalf of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Redmond and its municipal waterworks utility, that it grant a perpetual electrical transmission line easement to Puget Sound Power & Light Company across certain real property owned by the City in its municipal waterworks utility, and is satisfied that due consideration and cooperation has been made to the proper location of said line to satisfy the requirements of Resolution No. 129, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND:

1. That the City of Redmond grant an easement to Puget Sound Power & Light Company for the installation and maintenance of an electrical transmission line over and across the following described property located in King County, Washington:

The north 200 feet of the south half of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

subject to the provisions contained in the minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council held August 24, 1965, and subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to the form of said easement.

2. That the Mayor be authorized and empowered to sign and execute said easement for and on behalf of the City of Redmond.


3. That the provisions of Resolution No. 129 are hereby declared satisfied.
