

ORDINANCE NO. 1561

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION FOUR (4) OF ORDINANCE 1503 OF THE CITY OF REDMOND TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FOR SANDWICH BOARD SIGNS FROM THE PROHIBITION ON PORTABLE SIGNS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1503, passed by the City Council on August 1, 1989, granted a temporary exemption for sandwich board signs from the prohibition on portable signs and established criteria for the temporary utilization of these signs pending adoption of permanent revisions to the sign code, and

WHEREAS, Section four (4) of Ordinance 1503 provides that the ordinance shall expire and be of no further effect upon either adoption of permanent revisions to the City's sign ordinance after consideration of the Planning Commission recommendation provided for above, or upon the expiration of nine months from the effective date of the ordinance, whichever shall occur first, unless extended by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, formal review of such revisions and conduct of a public hearing by the Planning Commission cannot be completed prior to the expiration of Ordinance 1503 due to the backlog of already scheduled matters requiring processing by the Planning Department and consideration by the Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing circumstances, the City Council has determined that an amendment to Section four (4) of Ordinance 1503 extending the effective date of the ordinance is necessary in order to continue allowing the use of sandwich board signs within portions of the City zoned CC and CB until the formal Planning Commission public hearing, review and recommendation process can be completed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Extension of Temporary Exemption for Sandwich Boards. Section four (4) of Ordinance 1503 of the City of Redmond is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Term of Ordinance. This ordinance shall expire and be of no further effect upon either adoption of permanent revisions to the City's sign ordinance after consideration of the Planning Commission Recommendation provided for above, or upon an expiration date of October 30, 1990, whichever shall first occur, unless extended by the City Council.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.
