

RESOLUTION NO. 158

A RESOLUTION, fixing the time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of a portion of Northrup Way (AKA N.E. 18th Place.)

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street has been filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council January 25, 1966, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain street and public way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, described as follows:

That portion of the County Road No. 966 (AKA Northrup Road No. 1431, AKA N.E. 18th Place, AKA Howard Road) in the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 26, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., lying easterly of 148th Avenue N.E. (AKA Road No. 334) and southerly of a line 30 feet south of and parallel to the north line of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 26.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED


That the date of FEBRUARY 23, 1966, at the hour of 8:00 P.M., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Street to be held at the City Hall before the City Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

That the City Clerk give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.
