Speed Limit Revisions 148 Ave NE and Avondale Rd

ORDINANCE NO. 1593

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SECTION 10.24.060 AMENDING OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 30 MPH TO 40 MPH ON 148TH AVENUE N.E. FROM N.E. 60TH STREET TO 300 FEET SOUTH OF N.E. STREET; INCREASE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 30 MPH TO 40 MPH FOR SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON 148TH AVENUE N.E. FROM 300 FEET SOUTH OF N.E. 75TH STREET TO REDMOND WAY; ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT OF 30 MPH ON THE 148TH AVENUE N.E. EXTENSION FROM REDMOND WAY TO WILLOWS ROAD; AND INCREASE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 35 MPH TO 40 MPH ON AVONDALE ROAD FROM REDMOND WAY TO THE NORTH CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has recommended that the speed limit changes set forth hereinafter are necessary to provide for the safe and efficient flow of traffic, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a) increase the speed limit from 30 MPH to 40 MPH on 148th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 60th Street to 300 feet south of N.E. 75th Street;
- b) increase the speed limit from 30 MPH to 40 MPH for southbound traffic on 148th Avenue N.E. from 300 feet south of N.E. 75th Street to Redmond Way;
- c) establish a speed limit of 30 MPH on the 148th Avenue N.E. extension from Redmond Way to Willows Road;
- d) increase the speed limit from 35 MPH to 40 MPH on Avondale Road from Redmond Way to the north City limits.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after this ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title is published.
