AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO CITY
BUDGETS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 1597

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has identified the need to make certain revisions to the 1991 City budget, and the City Council has reviewed the proposed adjustment and has determined that it should be made, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 1597 adopting the 1991 budget, passed by the City Council on November 29, 1990, is hereby amended by revising Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 1597, to authorize the expenditure of \$155,000 to fund five additional firefighters to provide around the clock staffing of Fire Station 15. The source of funds for the increased appropriation is increased Fire District #34 intergovernmental revenue.

This Ordinance being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take full effect five (5) days after publication.
