

ORDINANCE: 1636

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING
1991 PAY RATES FOR FIRE FIGHTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond agreed through the collective bargaining process to grant across-the-board adjustments in pay for 1991 to City employees represented by the Redmond Fire Fighters Union (IAFF Local #2829); now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: "Pay Plan D - Redmond Fire Fighters Union", adopted by Ordinance Number 1604 is hereby amended, to grant a 6% increase in 1991 pay rates for Inspector/Investigators over rates of pay established by Ordinance 1604, and, further, to grant a 1.5% across-the-board increase in 1991 pay rates for Fire Fighters over rates of pay in effect 30 June 1991 and adjusting pay rates for other classifications represented by the bargaining unit as provided for in Appendix A of the current collective bargaining agreement as amended between the City and the Union, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2: When assigned as a Fire Inspector, a Fire Fighter will receive six percent (6%) incentive pay in addition to his or her regular pay for the entire period of his or her assignment. The incentive pay will not apply when the Fire Inspector serves as a relief Fire Fighter in an overtime capacity.

Section 3: The 6% increase in pay for Inspector/ Investigators effectuated by this ordinance shall take effect 1 January 1991. All other changes in pay rates, effectuated by this ordinance including the Fire Inspector incentive pay described in Section 2, shall take effect 1 July 1991.

Section 4: This ordinance, being an administrative action is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.
