ORDINANCE NO. 1637

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
MAKING ADJUSTMENTS IN THE SALARY PAID TO THE
MAYOR.

WHEREAS, based upon a review of compensation paid to
elected officials of comparable cities, the Elected Officials
Compensation Task Force has recommended an increase in the salary
applicable to the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the Task Force's
recommendation, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Mayor's Salary. The salary to be paid to
the Mayor shall continue at the current level of \$58,190.00 per
year until January 1, 1992, at which time the salary shall be
increased to \$62,500.00 per year plus any "across the board"
adjustment for cost of living granted to City department heads
for 1992. Thereafter, the Mayor shall annually receive the same
"across the board" adjustments for cost of living as those given
to City department heads.

Section 2. Repealer. Ordinance 1613, passed by the
City Council on February 19, 1991, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an
exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City
legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take

effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.
