ORDINANCE NO. 1638

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
MAKING ADJUSTMENTS IN THE SALARY AND BENEFITS
PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, based upon a review of compensation paid to elected officials of comparable cities, the Elected Officials Compensation Task Force has recommended an increase in the salary and benefits applicable to the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the Task Force's recommendation, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council Salaries. The salary to be paid to Redmond City Council members shall continue at the current level of \$550.00 per month until January 1, 1994, at which time the salary shall be increased to \$600.00 per month.

Section 2. Council Health Benefits. Health benefits matching those of other regular part-time employees of the City shall be provided to all Council members effective January 1, 1994.

Section 3. Deferred Compensation. Participation in the employee funded deferred compensation program is available to all Council members pursuant to the terms of the deferred compensation plan.

Section 4. Repealer. Ordinance 1389, passed by the City Council on November 2, 1987, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.
