ORDINANCE NO. 1681

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTIONS 13.08.010 AND 13.08.030 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE IN ORDER TO REVISE PROCEDURES FOR WATER SERVICE APPLICATION AND TO INCREASE THE INSTALLATION CHARGE FOR WATER METERS.

WHEREAS, Section 13.08.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code provides that applications for water service are to be made to the City Clerk, and

WHEREAS, Section 13.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal Code establishes the installation charges for water meters, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Utilities Division of the City Public Works Department, the City Council has determined that it would be more efficient to have the utilities division handle water service applications and that the installation charge for water meters should be increased, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Application for Water Services. Section 13.08.010 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.08.010 Application for Service. All persons desiring water service from the city water system are required to make application for such service with the Utility Division. All water service installations made to the

city water system shall be made by or under the direction of the Utility Division.

Section 2. Installation Charge. Section 13.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.08.030 Installation Charge. An installation charge shall be paid by all persons connecting to the water system at the time of approval of an application for service. The charge shall be based upon the size of the water meter as follows:

Meter Size	Cost
5/8" X 3/4" drop-in	\$ 260.00
1 inch drop-in	300.00
1.5 inch drop-in	420.00
2 inch drop-in	500.00
3/4 inch full service	\$1,400.00
1 inch full service	1,570.00
1.5 inch full service	1,760.00, or actual cost, whichever is greater
2 inch full service	1,850.00, or actual cost, whichever is greater

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being the exercise of a power specifically delegated to the legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect and be in force

May 1, 1992, which is more than five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.


