AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
SETTING 1992 PAY RATES FOR FIRE FIGHTERS, DRIVER/
OPERATORS, INSPECTOR/INVESTIGATORS, LIEUTENANTS,
AND CAPTAINS

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond agreed through the collective bargaining process to grant across-the-board increases in pay for 1992 to City employees represented by Redmond Fire Fighters Union #2829, I.A.F.F. and these increases should be reflected by changing an existing pay plan; now, therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "Pay Plan D - Redmond Fire Fighters Union"
covering employees represented by the Redmond Fire Fighters Union #2829, I.A.F.F. is hereby amended effective 1 January 1992 granting an across-the-board salary adjustment increasing by 4% rates of pay in effect 31 December 1991 as adopted by Ordinance 1636, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. "Pay Plan D - Redmond Fire Fighters Union" covering employees represented by the Redmond Fire Fighters Union #2829, I.A.F.F. is hereby amended effective 1 April 1992 to grant an across-the-board salary adjustment of 2.7%, which when combined with the across-the-board adjustment specified in Section 1 will increase the rates of pay in effect 31 December 1991 by a total of 6.7%, as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.
