## RESOLUTION NO. 169

A RESOLUTION, supporting the establishment of a four-year college on City-owned property in Redmond; and pledging the cooperation of the City in the availability of the site and the municipal services required.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is the owner of approximately 800 acres of land, described as follows:

Sec. 28, T 26 N, R 6 E, WM; and the NW% of Sec. 33, T 26 N, R 6 E, WM, in King County, Washington;

which was acquired by the Waterworks Utility of the City as a municipal watershed, but is no longer needed or used for such purposes and may be abandoned and disposed of by the City as surplus property; and

WHEREAS, an application has been submitted to the Temporary Advisory Council on Public Higher Education of the State of Washington, proposing that a public four-year college be located on such property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the proposal and finds that the location of a four-year college in the Redmond area would be in the best interests of the citizens of Redmond, King County, and the State of Washington, and that the City-owned property would make an ideal site for the location of such a college; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Redmond does hereby go on record as wholeheartedly supporting and endorsing the application for the establishment of a public four-year college in Redmond;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Redmond does hereby pledge its support and cooperation in making the above mentioned site available to the State of Washington for use as a public four-year college, in whole or in part, upon terms favorable to the State within the limits of its municipal authority and responsibilities to revenue bond holders of its Waterworks Utility;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Redmond does hereby pledge its support and cooperation

in supplying and furnishing the municipal services which will be required in the utilization of the site for a public fouryear college.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council and Mayor of the City of Redmond do hereby urge the strong support of the citizens of Redmond, surrounding communities and King County, and the representatives of State, County and local governments concerned in making possible the location of a four-year college in the Redmond area at the earliest practicable time as best serving the needs of the citizens seeking higher education through the extablishment of such college within commuting distance of a greater segment of the population.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 26th day of July, 1966.
