

RESOLUTION NO. 171

A RESOLUTION, expressing appreciation for the work of the GROW citizens' committee in submitting reports and recommendations for the improvement and acquisition of City Parks and for the construction of a new City Hall and Civic Center.

WHEREAS, a citizens committee known as GROW (Greater Redmond Organized Wisely) has been formed and has functioned to seek ways and means of bringing about the orderly growth and development of the Greater Redmond area, including the City of Redmond, through proper planning and implementation of programs designed to encourage and preserve an environment of living and progress beneficial to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council requested the GROW citizens' committee to undertake a study of the ways and means by which the parks and parks program of the City might be improved and to study ways and means by which the municipal quarters of the City of Redmond might be improved or replaced; and

WHEREAS, the GROW citizens' committee has submitted to the Mayor and City Council its report and recommendations for the improvement of the City Parks and City Hall facilities and has proposed that a general obligation bond issue be presented to the voters for such purposes; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed and studied the reports and recommendations of the GROW citizens' committee and find them worthy of comment and representative of an outstanding effort by interested citizens to bring about improvements in services of municipal government to its citizens; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the GROW citizens' committee be commended for the outstanding report and recommendations they have presented to the Mayor and City Council on needed improvements to the City Parks System and City Hall facilities and that GROW be complimented for having rendered such a fine example of public service to the officials and citizens of the City of Redmond.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Council does hereby extend its appreciation to the individuals and groups of the GROW Citizens' Committee who have devoted many hours of their time in the study and preparation of the GROW report and recommendations; and does hereby thank GROW for a job well done.
