ORDINANCE NO. 1733

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE 1717 AND
CHAPTER 13.22 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1717 of the City of Redmond bans the sale of laundry detergents containing phosphates within the City, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1717 was adopted to make Redmond consistent with unincorporated King County where a similar ban was imposed by King County Ordinance 92-285, and

WHEREAS, King County has advised the City of Redmond that King County intends to repeal Ordinance 92-285 because of the State's enactment of Chapter 118, Laws of 1993, limiting the sale of detergents containing phosphates state-wide, and the Redmond City Council has determined to repeal Ordinance 1717 in order to stay consistent with King County, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ban Repealed. Ordinance 1717 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on January 5, 1993, and Chapter 13.22 of the Redmond Municipal Code, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance, shall take effect and be in fully force thirty (30) days after its passage and publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.
