AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,  
WASHINGTON, REPEALING SECTION 9.04.020 OF THE  
REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Section 9.04.020 makes it unlawful for minors to  
be in a public place after consumption of alcohol, and


WHEREAS, Chapter 513, Laws of 1993, amends RCW 66.44.270  
to prohibit the same, or virtually the same, conduct by minors, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1735 of the City of Redmond adopted  
RCW 66.44.270, as amended by Chapter 513, Laws of 1993, thereby  
making RMC 9.04.020 unnecessary, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal. Section 9.04.020 of the Redmond  
Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an  
exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative  
body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5)  
days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof  
consisting of the title.
