RESOLUTION NO. 176

A RESOLUTION, endorsing and supporting H.B. 595 of the 1967 Legislature, providing for an increase of excise tax on motor vehicle fuels and for the distribution thereof to the state, counties and cities.

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 595 of the 40th Regular Session, 1967 Legislature provides for an increase in the excise tax on motor vehicle fuels and for the distribution of proceeds therefrom, together with the proceeds from the sale of limited obligation bonds, as deposited in the highway construction funds, to the state, county and cities for highway and street construction; and

WHEREAS, the cities of the State of Washington are in urgent need of additional funds for street construction and improvement and H.B. 595 would be instrumental in furnishing a part of such required funds; now, therefore


BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Redmond does hereby endorse and support the purposes of H.B. 595 and urges its passage by the 1967 Washington State Legislature.


