ORDINANCE NO. 1773

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE 1492 IN ORDER TO EXTEND THE NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE GRANTED TO WASHINGTON WASTE HAULING AND RECYCLING, INC., DBA WASTE MANAGEMENT - SNO-KING, FOR THE OPERATION OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF REDMOND.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1492 of the City of Redmond granted a nonexclusive franchise to Sno-King Garbage Company which is due to expire on May 31, 1994, and

WHEREAS, due to a reorganization of the Washington State entities of Sno-King's parent company, Waste Management Technologies, Inc., the name of the current franchise holder is Washington Waste Hauling and Recycling, Inc., dba Waste Management - Sno-King, and

WHEREAS, the City and the franchisee have agreed that the franchise should be extended through December 31, 1994, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Franchise Extended. The nonexclusive franchise granted to Sno-King Garbage Company, now Washington Waste Hauling and Recycling, Inc., dba Waste Management - Sno-King, by Ordinance 1492 of the City of Redmond, is hereby extended through December 31, 1994 and Section 2 of Ordinance 1492 is hereby amended

to read as follows:


Section 2. Franchise Granted - Term. The City of Redmond hereby grants to Washington Waste Hauling and Recycling, Inc, dba Waste Management - Sno-King (hereinafter referred to as "franchisee") a nonexclusive franchise to operate a garbage and refuse collection and removal business in the City of Redmond. This franchise shall be for garbage and refuse collection and removal only and shall not include the collection and removal of recyclable materials or special wastes. The term of this franchise shall be through December 31, 1994, at which time it shall automatically expire.

Section 2. Other Terms. All terms of Ordinance 1492, as amended above, shall continue to remain in full force and effect and govern the franchise granted to Washington Waste Hauling and Recycling, Inc., dba Waste Management - Sno-King for the remainder of the extended franchise term, i.e., through December 31, 1994.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being the exercise of a power specifically delegated to the legislative body of the City pursuant to RCW 35A.47.040, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title, provided, that the franchise extension granted herein shall not become effective,

nor shall any rights be conveyed by such grant, until the franchisee shall have signified its acceptance of the terms set forth herein and in Ordinance 1492 for the extension. The Franchisee shall signify acceptance by signing the original ordinance and/or by operating a garbage and refuse collection and removal business in Redmond after May 31, 1994. In the event that the Franchisee shall fail to sign this Ordinance within thirty (30) days after passage, the extension shall become null and void and the franchise shall automatically expire May 31, 1994..
