

RESOLUTION NO. 178

A RESOLUTION, relating to park and recreational programs; providing for a cooperation agreement with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton; and authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, through its Park Commission has explored the possibility of establishing a teen-age recreational activities center in Kirkland, Washington in cooperation with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton, and finds it mutually advantageous to enter into a cooperation agreement for such purposes and to authorize the expenditure of funds therefor; and

WHEREAS, there is authority for such a joint action and contribution through the park and recreational programs of each city pursuant to RCW 67.20.020; Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, as follows:

1. That the City of Redmond does hereby enter into a cooperation agreement with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton for the establishment of a teen-age recreational activities center to be located in the basement of the Kirkland Civic Center Building in Kirkland, Washington, and does authorize an expenditure to make contribution toward said program from its park and recreational funds in a sum not to exceed \$ 700.⁰⁰.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 14th day of February, 1967.


