

An Ordinance Prohibiting Automobiles engaged in the
Transportation Business from Standing on
Certain streets.

17-A

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond:-

1. Automobiles, stages and other vehicles engaged in the transportation business or that are for hire are hereby prohibited from standing on Leary Street in the Town of Redmond between Railroad Avenue and Jackson Street and on Railroad Avenue between Leary Ave. and First Ave. for any longer time than shall be necessary for the loading or unloading of passengers therefrom and any person or persons permitting such automobiles, stages or vehicles to so remain shall be guilty of misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars or

not less than five days in town jail on both such fine and imprisonment.
Passed by the Council this 12 day of April, 1914.
