ORDINANCE NUMBER 18

An Ordinance Relating to the Municipal Water Supply System of The Town of Redmond, Regulating the Use of the Water therefrom, Providing for the sale of the same, Fixing the Price thereof, and Providing the method of Collecting Rates therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Redmond as follows:-

I.

APPLICATION FOR WATER.

Any person desiring to have premises connected with the water supply system of the town of Redmond shall make application therefor upon a form to be furnished for that purpose, which application shall contain a description of the premises where such water is desired and the number of families to be supplied therefrom; whether the same is for domestic or commercial use and shall indicate that the applicant agrees to be bound by the terms of this Ordinance and shall be signed by the owner of the premises to be served, or his duly authorized agent; shall be filed in the office of the Town Clerk and at the time of filing such application the applicant shall pay to the Town Treasurer and take his receipt therefor, the fees for installation of water service hereinafter provided.

II.

INSTALLATION OF WATER.

The fee for installation of water service as herein above provided shall be Seven and 50/100ths (\$7.50) Dollars. Upon receipt of an application as hereinabove provided and the payment of the above stated fee, the Town of Redmond will cause the premises described in the application, if the same abut upon a street where there is a city water main, to be connected with the city's water main by a service pipe extending from the main

to the property line and including a shut-off placed either within the street or immediately within the property line of the person to be so served, which connection and which shut-off shall thereafter be maintained by and kept within the exclusive control of the Town of Redmond. In case application is made for water service on premises not abutting upon a street where there is a city water main, the city will lay its connection from the main towards the premises for a distance equal to the distance from the main to the curb line.

III.

RATES FOR WATER.

The monthly rates for the use of water shall be as follows: For domestic service to each house so served \$1.00, for commercial purposes to each business house served \$1.75. The above rates shall not, however prevent the town council from time to time fixing special rates for business or other uses aside from the ordinary domestic and commercial uses such as at present exist in the town of Redmond.

Water rates as above specified shall be payable monthly in advance, payment to be made to the Town Treasurer on or before the 10th day of each month. If the said payment be not so made on or prior to the 10th day of the month, a penalty of twenty five cents will attach and the Town Treasurer on the 11th day of the month shall turn over to the Town clerk a list of all water users whose payments are delinquent and the said Town clerk shall then proceed to collect the same together with the said penalty, and if the same be not promptly paid then, at the discretion of the Town clerk, water shall be shut off from the said premises.

IV.

USE OF WATER.

Water so furnished by the Town of Redmond may be used for ordinary domestic or commercial purposes, for the sprinkling of streets and for the irrigation of such tract of land as would ordinarily be used as a lawn and garden for one family; but permission for such use shall not carry with it the right to irrigate any extensive quantity of land and the Council reserves to itself and to its water committee the right to fix rates at any time for the irrigation of larger tracts of land. , If any consumer wastes water or allows it to be wasted by imperfect or leaky connections, faucets or other apertures, then at the discretion of the water committee of the Town Council water may be cut off from the said premises.

V.

REDUCTION OF RATES FOR VACANCIES.

Whenever any premises connected with the water supply system of the Town of Redmond shall become vacant and the owner thereof desires to have the rates remitted for the non-use of water upon the said premises, he shall on or before the 1st day of the current month file with the Town clerk a notice of such vacancy and shall pay a fee of fifty cents and the Town will then cause said water to be shut off and no further water rate shall be charged until the said water is ordered turned on, and the same shall be turned on at any time without charge for such service.

VI.

RATES CHARGED AGAINST PROPERTY.

All water rates will be charged against the property for which the service was installed and against the owner thereof and if for any cause any sums owing therefor become delinquent

the water shall be shut off and in no case shall it be turned on to the said property until all such delinquencies have been paid in full. Only one house, building or premise may be supplied for the rate above provided, but two houses, buildings or premises may use the same service connection provided, however, the property owner to whose premises such connection is made shall be responsible for all houses, buildings or premises using water from such service connection, and no premises shall be permitted to furnish water for use on other premises without the payment of an additional water rate for the premises so served.

VII.

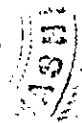
CITY RESERVES RIGHT TO SHUT OFF

The City reserves the right to at any time shut off the water supply for repairs, extension, non-payment of rates, or any other reason and the city shall not be responsible for any damage resulting from any interruption of the water supply or resulting from the shut off of water.
