ORDINANCE NO. 1835

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, FIXING THE SALARY TO BE PAID TO THE MAYOR AT \$72,000 PER YEAR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1637 EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1996.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1637 of the City of Redmond fixed the salary of the office of Mayor and provided for annual "across the board" adjustments for cost of living in the same amounts as those given to department heads, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the salary of the Mayor should be a fixed amount without automatic increases, and that any increases should be approved by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the office of Mayor will be up for election in 1995 and the Council wishes to make the necessary adjustments in the salary ordinance prior to the beginning of the filing period for the position, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Mayor's Salary. Effective January 1, 1996, the salary to be paid to the Mayor shall be \$72,000.00 per year, payable in equal periodic installments according to the same pay schedule as other City employees.

Section 2. Repealer. Ordinance No. 1637 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on June 18, 1991, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force January 1, 1996, which is more than five (5) days after its passage and publication, as provided by law.
