

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 188

A RESOLUTION, relating to park and recreational programs; providing for the continuation of the cooperation agreement with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton for the establishment and operation of a teen-age recreational activities center; and authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, together with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton, entered into a cooperation agreement for the establishment of a teen-age recreational activities center in the Kirkland Civic Center, which was recently destroyed by fire; and

WHEREAS, substitute facilities are available for the program at the Saint John's Episcopal Church in Kirkland which will involve a monthly financial commitment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council pursuant to Resolution No. 178 did previously approve the cooperation agreement and authorize the expenditure of funds therefor under the authority of RCW 67.20.020 and it is deemed to be in the mutual interests of the three cities involved to continue the program for teen-age recreational activities, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, as follows:

1. That the City of Redmond, having previously entered into a cooperation agreement with the cities of Kirkland and Houghton for the establishment of a teen-age recreational activities center, does hereby affirm the continuation of the program.


2. That an expenditure to make contribution towards the program is hereby authorized from the park and recreational funds of the City in a sum not to exceed \$150.00 monthly, beginning September 1, 1967, as one-third (1/3rd) of the monthly cost of operation of a teen-age recreational activities center for the remainder of the year 1967.

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to act as the representative of the City of Redmond in appointing and working with a committee to supervise and administer the teen-age recreational activities center.




