AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE SR520 RIGHT-OF-WAY NORTH OF MARYMOOR PARK FROM THE INTERCHANGE OF SR520 AND REDMOND WAY UP TO AND INCLUDING THE INTERSECTION OF SR520 AND WEST LAKE SAMMAMISH PARKWAY.

WHEREAS, on <u>February 2, 199</u>6, the City of Redmond received a Notice of Intent to Annex certain real property commonly known as a portion of SR520, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interests of the City to assume jurisdiction over this portion of SR520 and West Lake Sammamish Parkway, and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.21.790 permits the legislative bodies of counties and cities to revise, by agreement, any part of the corporate boundary of the City which coincides with the edge of a public street or right-of-way, and provides that such boundary revision becomes effective when approved by ordinance of the City Council and the King County Council

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: -

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Annexation and Boundary Revision.</u> Pursuant to RCW 35.21.790, the corporate boundary of the City of Redmond shall be revised, to include the right-of-way legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto and shown on the map on Exhibit B and

incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full, and to annex the same to the City subject to approval of such revision by an ordinance of King County Council.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being the exercise of a power specifically delegated to the legislative body of the City, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title, provided that the annexation provided for in Section 1 shall become effective at such time as the King County Council approves, the annexation of the property described on Exhibit A to the City of Redmond.




STATEMENT OF FACT:



SUBJECT: SR 520 ANNEXATION

Dear Mr. Peterson:

Enclosed is a certified copy of the annexation ordinance, Ordinance No. 1881, that was passed by the Redmond City Council on March 19, 1996. As we have discussed, the State Department of Transportation came to the City of Redmond seeking to annex this portion of highway right-of-way to facilitate their permitting process for HOV lanes or any other future changes. This annexation has been reviewed by the King County Transportation department and they are in agreement with the annexation. Because a portion of West Lake Sammamish Parkway, lies directly underneath the SR 520 interchange, this roadway too becomes annexed into Redmond with the same ordinance. This action alleviates the County's responsibility for maintenance and traffic control for this section of roadway. In order to complete the annexation as allowed by RCW 35.21.790, the King County Council must pass a similar ordinance for the annexation to become effective. I am sending you this document so that your staff can begin drafting a similar ordinance for the King County Council. I will be expecting to hear from you once you can give me information on timing. Your help is appreciated.
