RESOLUTION NO. 190

A RESOLUTION, relating to the construction of the Third Lake Washington Bridge; and endorsing the plans of the State Highway Department.

WHEREAS, a public hearing on access is to be held on September 28, 1967 at Mercer Island, Washington concerning the plans of the State Highway Department for the construction of the Third Lake Washington Bridge and the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington does endorse and support such plans, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Redmond, as follows: That the Highway Department, The Highway Commission and The Bureau of Public Roads be urged to proceed with all possible dispatch with the construction and completion of the Third Lake Washington Bridge on Interstate Route 90 in accordance with Highway Department plans and with earliest scheduling and with no major design changes.

2. That the City of Redmond does wholeheartedly endorse and support the early completion of the Third Lake Washington Bridge as essential to the commerce, transportation and economy of the area east of Lake Washington; the City of Seattle; and the entire State of Washington.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 26TH day of September, 1967.
