

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 192

A RESOLUTION, approving the determination of the cost of acquisition of certain joint use sewer facilities from Lake Hills Sewer District of King County, Washington, in the total amount of \$21,425.21.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond and Lake Hills Sewer District of King County, Washington, have been involved in litigation concerning sanitary sewerage service in an area annexed to the City in 1964, known as the Viewpoint Area, a portion of which also lay within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, the court in such litigation has directed the parties to determine the method for transferring facilities and service responsibilities within the annexed area from the District to the City and the parties have been working towards an agreement to accomplish such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the consulting engineers for the City and the District have determined the capital costs of the general facilities to be transferred, subject to a continuing right of joint use by the District, and have determined the percentage utilization of such facilities by the City and the District, and have recommended resulting amounts to be paid by the City to the District for such facilities in the total sum of \$21,425.21; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the recommendations made and finds the same should be approved, Now, Therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED That the following be approved as the amounts to be paid by the City to the District for the transfer of the facilities shown below to the City, subject to the continuing right of joint use by the District:


