

RESOLUTION NO. 193

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO CONTRACT FOR URBAN PLANNING ASSISTANCE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, desires to provide for a planning study contributing to an over-all program for future community development, the preservation of community values, the prevention of conditions tending to cause urban blight, and the promotion of the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens: and,

WHEREAS, the State Planning and Community Affairs Agency, under authority of Chapters 74, Statutes 1967, Regular Session, may provide planning assistance for such a program and receive financial assistance from the Urban Renewal Administration, as authorized by Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954: as amended by the Housing Act of 1959 and again by the Housing Act of 1960; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Redmond hereby requests the State Planning and Community Affairs Agency to provide planning assistance under authority of Chapters 74, Statutes 1967, Regular Session, with such financial assistance as may be provided by the Urban Renewal Administration, under authority of Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954 (P.L. 860, 83rd Congress), as amended by the Housing Act of 1959 (P.L. 86-372, 86th Congress). That such planning assistance is more particularly described in a project description that is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution as if fully set forth herein.

THAT, the City Council, subject to approval of such planning assistance by the State and Federal authorities, hereby authorizes:

- (a) Payment to the State Planning and Community Affairs Agency of a sum not to exceed \$4,000.00 in cash and,
- (b) Use of personnel of the City of Redmond for technical assistance in this project, which assistance has an estimated value of \$ 3,500.00.

THAT, the total estimated cost of the City of Redmond's project as planned is \$ 22,500.00.

THAT, the authorized official of the City of Redmond be, the Mayor, and he hereby is, authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Redmond all necessary contracts and agreements to implement and carry out the purposes specified in this resolution.
