

ORDINANCE NO: 1936

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING 1997 SALARIES FOR MAINTENANCE POSITIONS REPRESENTED BY THE WASHINGTON STATE COUNCIL OF COUNTY AND CITY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond agreed through the collective bargaining process to grant an across-the-board increase in 1997 salaries to Parks and Public Works maintenance employees represented by the Washington State Council of County and City Employees and these increases should be reflected by amending Pay Plan "A" - AFSCME; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "Pay Plan A - AFSCME", covering Parks and Public Works maintenance employees represented by the Washington State Council of County and City Employees is hereby amended by granting a 2.7% across-the-board increase in 1997 salaries over salaries in effect 31 December 1996 as adopted by Ordinance No. 1858 as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The salary adjustment called for in Section 1 is effective January 1, 1997.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.
