ORDINANCE NO. 1957

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO CITY BUDGETS, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 1921 AND 1938.

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has identified the need to make certain revisions to the 1997-1998 biennial City budget, and the City Council has reviewed the proposed adjustments and has determined that they should be made, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1921 adopting the 1997-1998 biennial budget, passed by the City Council on December 17, 1996, and amended by Ordinance No. 1938 on May 20, 1997, is hereby further amended by revising Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 1921, to reflect the increased appropriations set forth in Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. The sources of funds for the increased appropriations are grant monies, telecommunication right-of-way agreement fees and lease revenue, proceeds from the sale of limited tax general obligation notes, beginning fund balances, interfund transfers, and private contributions.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
